
John's Gospel is telling us that we are meant to echo the *nature* of Christ's love.

5. A Church "out of every tribe, tongue, people and nation"

d) In the face of increasingly hostile attitudes toward migrants, we are called to practice an open welcome, to accompany them in the construction of a new life and to build a true intercultural communion

among peoples. Respect for the liturgical traditions and religious practices of migrants is an integral part of an authentic welcome.

e) The Church teaches the need for and encourages the practice of interreligious dialogue as part of building communion among all peoples. In a world of violence and fragmentation, a witness is ever more urgent to the unity of humanity, its common origin and common destiny, in a coordinated and reciprocal solidarity toward social justice, peace, reconciliation and care for our common home. The Church is aware that the Spirit can speak through women and men of every religion, belief and culture.


