- **Formation for Service to Families and Marriage:**
We are a faith community that accompanies families, fully recognizing the centrality of marriage and family in God’s plan. The Pastoral Priorities will inform and permeate all initiatives and events in the Archdiocese and our Catholic community over the next three years from 2024 to 2027. Wednesday Evening Catechism:

This program is for children attending public schools, from Kindergarten to Grade 6. Registration and the first class will be on **Wednesday, September 25th** from 6–7pm upstairs in the Kateri Common Room. While families register, children will attend class. Classes will run Wednesdays from 6-7pm, beginning September 25th to mid-May. Please bring a copy of your child's **baptism certificate** if they were baptized at a church other than Holy Trinity Parish. A \$15.00 registration fee is required to cover the cost of the workbook. Payment can be made by cash, cheque or e-transfer holytrinity.sg@caedm.ca Please include child's name.

Wednesday Evening Rite of Christian Initiation for Children (RCIC):

This program is for children ages 6 – 12 who have not yet been baptized. It is a weekly class designed to prepare children to receive the Sacraments at Easter. Registration will be upstairs in the Kateri Common Room on Wednesday, **September 25th** from 6-7pm. While families register, children will attend class. Classes will run Wednesdays from 6-7pm, September 25th to mid-May. Please bring a copy of your child's **long-form birth certificate (showing parentage)**.
