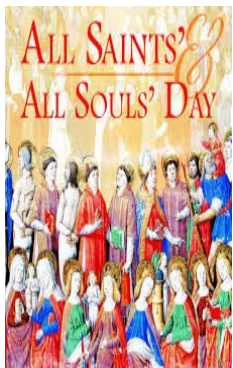

PONDERINGS FROM THE GOSPEL:

In Mark's Gospel, Jesus constantly associates with "the unclean" of his society. Bartimaeus, the blind beggar, exhibits a lot of faith and gumption in persistently calling out to Jesus when the crowd keeps shushing him. Bartimaeus is disturbing their peace; the crowd wants to listen to Jesus, not some beggar 'nobody.' How often do we shush inconvenient, bothersome people in our lives? Yet Bartimaeus teaches us how to pray: ask simply, honestly, and persistently for the desire of your heart. Jesus always hears what others do not want to hear: the cries of the poor unclean "nobodies."

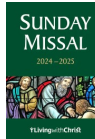
