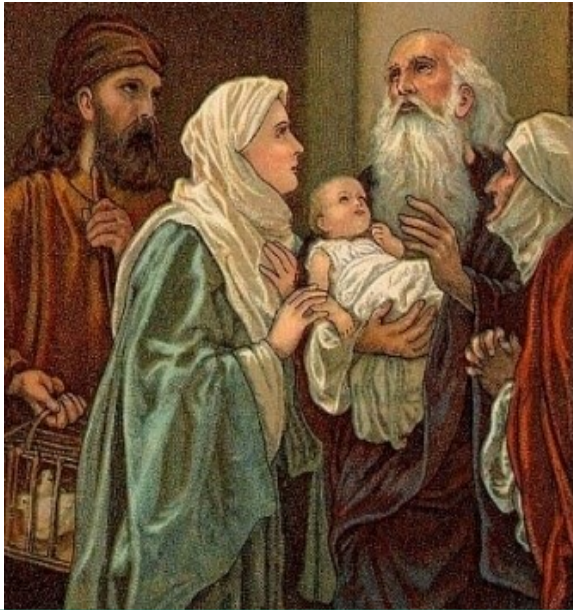


HOLY TRINITY CATHOLIC CHURCH

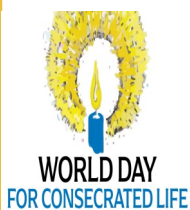
WORLD DAY OF THE SICK
Tuesday, February 11
Masses at 9:30am and 6:30pm

This has been an annual observation introduced by John Paul II as a way for believers of the Catholic faith to offer prayers and good wishes to those currently suffering from illness.



Each year, the day coincides with the commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes, celebrated as a liturgical feast by Catholics. World Day of the Sick provides an important opportunity for those who serve in Catholic health ministry to reflect on caring for those who are sick and those who provide care.

Anointing of the Sick will be offered by Father Paul and Father Joselito to those who are in need of the Sacrament of Healing at the above Masses.



February 2:
WORLD DAY FOR CONSECRATED LIFE

The purpose of this day is "to help the entire Church to esteem ever more greatly the witness of those persons who have chosen to follow Christ by means of the practice of the evangelical counsels" as well as "to be a suitable occasion for consecrated persons to renew their commitment and rekindle the fervor which should inspire their offering of themselves to the Lord". Today is also a day to highlight the role of consecrated people in spreading the light and love of Jesus Christ.

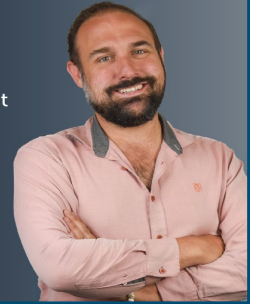
