### THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD January 12, 2025



In today's Gospel of Luke we hear the proclamation of the baptism of Jesus with "all the people." Indeed, "heaven was opened" and the Father announced his special favor. Whenever we partake of the body and blood of Christ, heed his call in our daily lives, share his Good News, become instruments of his transforming justice and peace, heaven is opened to us, and through the Holy Spirit, the Lord announces his special favor on us as well.

Sunday, February 2 Feast of the Presentation of the Lord (also known as Candlemas day)

All Masses the weekend of February 1-2 will

begin with a procession and the blessing of candles. If you have any candles that you wish to be blessed, you may bring them to the Church on that day so that they may receive the blessing offered on this feast. This ancient feast marks the midpoint of winter, halfway between the shortest day and the spring equinox.

This commemorates the ritual purification of Mary, 40 days after the birth of Jesus. On this day, Christians remember the presentation of Jesus Christ in the Temple. Forty days after the birth of a Jewish boy, it was the custom to take him to the temple in Jerusalem to be presented to God by his thankful parents.

In pre-Christian times this day was known as the "Feast of Lights" and was celebrated as winter gave way to spring.
