

In today's second reading we hear Saint Paul teach the community at Ephesus that God's revelation had come, not just to their community, but to others as well; that a broader community of believers was being allowed to exercise stewardship over the Good News. Good stewards recognize that it is in our life together as a Eucharistic community that we find ever new vistas and insights into God's vast universe of love and mercy. If we take time to listen to one another, we discover stories of



MASS INTENTION REQUESTS:

Please note the following changes for booking Mass intentions that are to be prayed at Holy Trinity:

- Beginning immediately we will only book "NEW" Mass intentions for the coming 2 months. Once these 2 months are full, the intentions will be sent out of the Parish to clergy who are serving in other Archdiocesan capacities or to a mission priest.
- In view of the volume of requests we receive, each parishioner will be allowed to book 1 Mass at one time, with the remainder being sent out.
- The suggested stipend remains at \$10.00 per Mass.
- Mass intentions are not printed in the Bulletin, but will continue to be **announced** at Mass.

This is not to discourage anyone from asking for Masses to be offered for their loved ones—it is an effort to try to be fair to everyone who is requesting Masses so that the Masses may be offered in a timely fashion.
