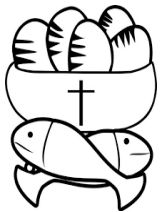

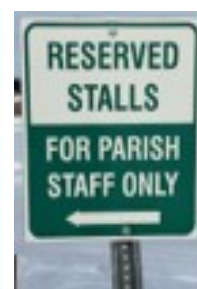

"do to others as you would have them do to you".

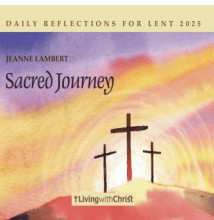

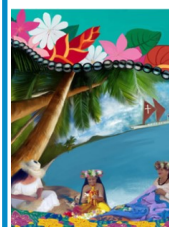
