In Luke's gospel he tells the story of Jesus calling Simon Peter (and other fishermen) to be his disciples, symbolized by a miraculous catch of fish where they caught so many fish that their nets were nearly breaking; this event is often referred to as the "Miraculous Catch of Fish" and is significant because it demonstrates Jesus' power over nature and calls Peter to leave his old life behind to follow Jesus and "fish for men" (meaning to bring people to God) instead.

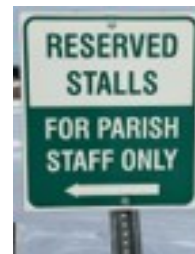
