# **DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY**

The message of The Divine Mercy is simple. It is that **God loves us—all of us**. And, he wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. Thus, all will come to share His joy.

Divine Mercy is God's love reaching down to meet the needs and overcome the miseries of His creatures. The Bible, the teachings of St. Thomas Aquinas, and Pope John Paul II all assure us that this is so. The Old Testament provides us with many images of human misery and of God in His mercy seeking to relieve it.

### A — Ask for God's Mercy:

God wants us to fervently approach Him in prayer, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world. God completely understands us and accepts us as we are.

### B — Be merciful:

God desires for us to receive the fullness of His mercy and allow it to flow through us to our loved ones, our workplace, and our society.

To be merciful is not just an option of the Divine Mercy Devotion; it's a requirement! Luke 6.36 "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful,"

# C — Completely trust in Jesus:

God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust.

The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.

Simply because if we do not desire, we will be closed to receiving.

"Jesus, I trust in You!"


# THANK YOU TO ALL LITURGICAL MINISTRIES:
