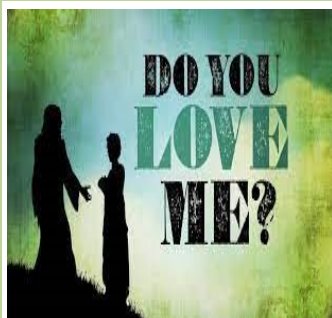

below the 2024 Summary of Parish
Finances.

The parish has two bank accounts, **one is for your donations**
given in the white envelopes and special collections and all
church expenses, the **second is for saving for the Site
Completion** (a reminder we currently get our water from a well
and have a septic field and will need to pay for City services
once development reaches our area).

at the parish.

Total Expenses: \$1,193,791.38
