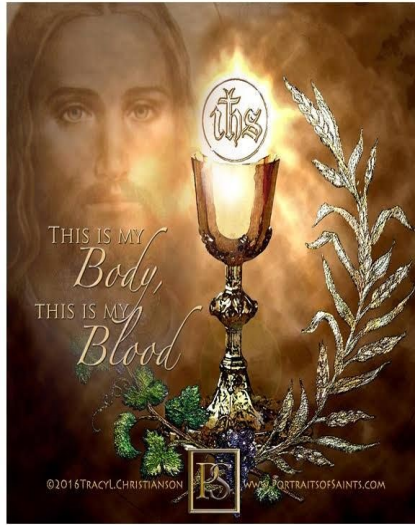


HOLY TRINITY CATHOLIC CHURCH

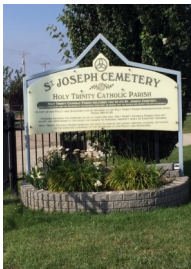

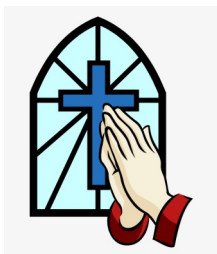
