


# HOLY TRINITY CATHOLIC CHURCH

## Exaltation of the Cross—September 14, 2025



In John's Gospel, Jesus' death on the cross as well as his resurrection and return to the Father are one event. For him, the cross is a sign of exaltation.

The serpent that Moses lifted up in the desert to offer healing to those injured by snake bites prefigures Jesus' being lifted up on the cross, bringing salvation. The eternal life God offers through Jesus is not life without end but life lived in the unending presence of God. That is why it can begin now in this life. The world to which God sends the Son is not a place but those people who are at odds with Jesus and God. Jesus is sent to this world as a gift. Only believers accept the gift. Finally, God's judgment on the world is not a future cosmic event but a present reality. God sent the Son out of love for the world. However, the world has to decide to accept him. Those who accept him have eternal life at the moment of the decision. Those who reject him don't.





## CATECHISM, RCIC Programs— and HOMESCHOOLING:



### Wednesday Evening Catechism:

This program is for children attending public schools, from Kindergarten to Grade 6. Registration and the first class will be on **Wednesday, September 24<sup>th</sup>** from 6–7pm in the classroom upstairs. While families register, children will attend class. Classes will run Wednesdays from 6-7pm, September 24<sup>th</sup> to mid-May. Please bring a copy of your child's baptism certificate if they were baptized at a church other than Holy Trinity Parish. A \$15.00 registration fee is required to cover the cost of the workbook. Payment can be made by cash, cheque or e-transfer [holytrinity.sg@caedm.ca](mailto:holytrinity.sg@caedm.ca). Please include child's name.

### Wednesday Evening Rite of Christian Initiation for Children (RCIC):

This program is for children ages 6 – 12 who have not yet been baptized. It is a weekly class designed to prepare children to receive the Sacraments at Easter. Registration will be on **Wednesday, September 24<sup>th</sup> from 6-7 pm** in the classroom upstairs. While families register, children will attend class. Classes will run Wednesdays from 6-7pm, September 24<sup>th</sup> to mid-May. 
