Tradition: What is it? Why do we have it?

Tradition makes something personal and draws us into relationship with others. It may be formal, it may be something we always did “just because” (maybe we don’t know why). We have traditions with our families and friends that help define the unique relationship we have with them, and sets apart those events and times as something out of the ordinary.

The Catechism defines Tradition as “The living transmission of the message of the Gospel in the Church. The oral preaching of the Apostles, and the written message of salvation under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit (Bible), are conserved and handed on as the deposit of faith through the apostolic succession in the Church. Both the living Tradition and the written Scriptures have their common source in the revelation of God in Jesus Christ. The theological, liturgical, disciplinary, and devotional traditions of the local churches both contain and can be distinguished from this apostolic Tradition.”

These traditions draw us into a personal relationship with God and set that relationship apart from all others. They also draw us into relationship with our Catholic family: the Holy Angels in Heaven, the faithful gone before us whether they are Holy Saints in Heaven or Holy Souls in Purgatory, and the faithful of the Church still on earth — including those in our own parish and all others around the world. Wow! Who else has such an amazing family?

As we approach Thanksgiving and the traditions each of you may have, the Arts & Environment Team would like to wish you all a very blessed Thanksgiving!

 person (adults only).





